## CPT APPLICATION FOR ART AND ARCHITECTURE STUDENTS

This application must be submitted to the Office for International Student & Scholars (OISS) *at least* three business days prior to your first day of the internship. You are not eligible to begin the internship until you have the new I-20 that specifically authorizes you for CPT.

In order to be eligible for CPT, you must complete one academic year of full-time study. You must also be enrolled for a CPT-approved course as determined by the Sam Fox School.

The CPT authorization is valid between the dates and for the employer indicated on Page 2 of the I-20. If you need additional time, you must apply for an extension of the CPT before the current CPT period expires.

If you anticipate using 12 months or more full-time CPT, please talk to an International Student Advisor about how it will affect your eligibility for Optional Practical Training. Students that use 12 months of full-time CPT are no longer eligible for OPT.
