Participation in Curricular Practical Training (CPT) requires registration in A46 590 Training and Development in Practice.

A46 590 Training and Development in Practice is a practicum course offering students who qualify the opportunity to participate in an internship, or professional immersion experience. While the structure of the course affords student participants a great measure of autonomy as far as the scheduling and work demands associated with their internship, the course will provide a framework for the student and instructor to proactively set reasonable learning/experiential objectives and assess the completion of these objectives by the end of the course period.

You will receive a course syllabus that outlines the course requirements and meeting schedule no later than June 1st.

Students must confirm their eligibility to participate in CPT with the Office for International Students and Scholars (OISS).

Students may **not** begin their internships until they have been registered for A46 590 and their CPT applications have been approved by OISS.

Students may enroll in A46 590 Training and Development in Practice a maximum of three (3) times. Credits earned from A46 590 will not count toward fulfilling to a students' degree requirements. Students who do not satisfactorily complete the course requirements may not be approved to enroll in the course in a subsequent summer. Failure to complete the course requirements may result in the student's Optional Practical Training (OPT) application being denied.

The deadline for submitting this completed registration form to the Sam Fox Registrar's office is May 31st. Materials submitted after this deadline will not be accepted.
